## BALD EAGLE

This giant bird's look is a white head and tail, but it can take up to 4 years for the eagle to mature to that color! Juvenile eagles are brown and speckled with white.

## GOLDENEYE DUCKS

Flocks of these ducks can be seen on or near the river. Male ducks have dark heads with a white spot under their eyes.

## COYOTE TRACKS

Coyote tracks are large with long nails and an oval shape whereas dog prints are more circular!



## PILEATED WOODPECKERS

These BIG birds have a red mohawk and sound like a monkey, or laughter!

## FORESTVIEW WHITE PINE TUNNEL

White pines have clusters of 5 needles. Bonus if captured after snow fall!

## SASSAFRAS LEAVES

These leaves have three variations! A mitten shape, a 'chicken foot' and an oval shape.
