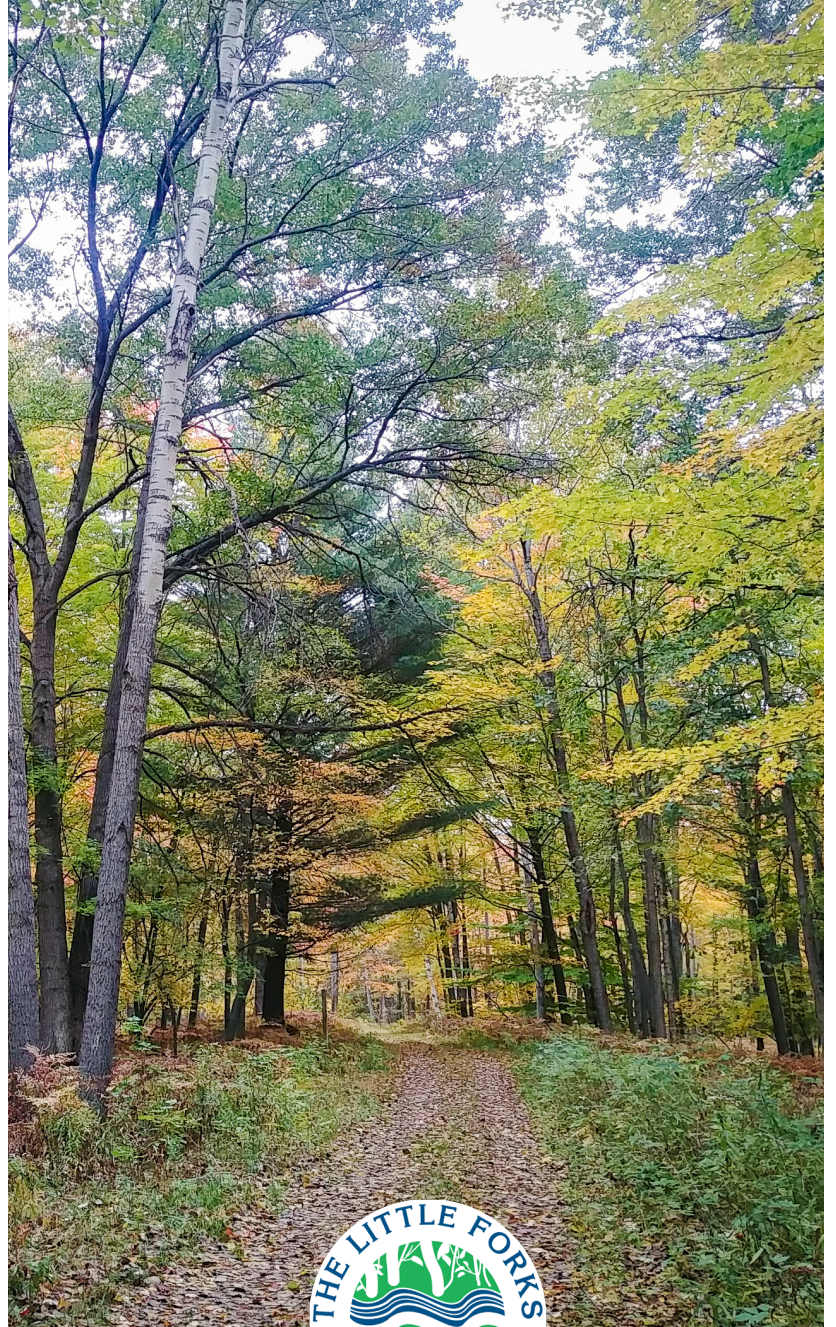

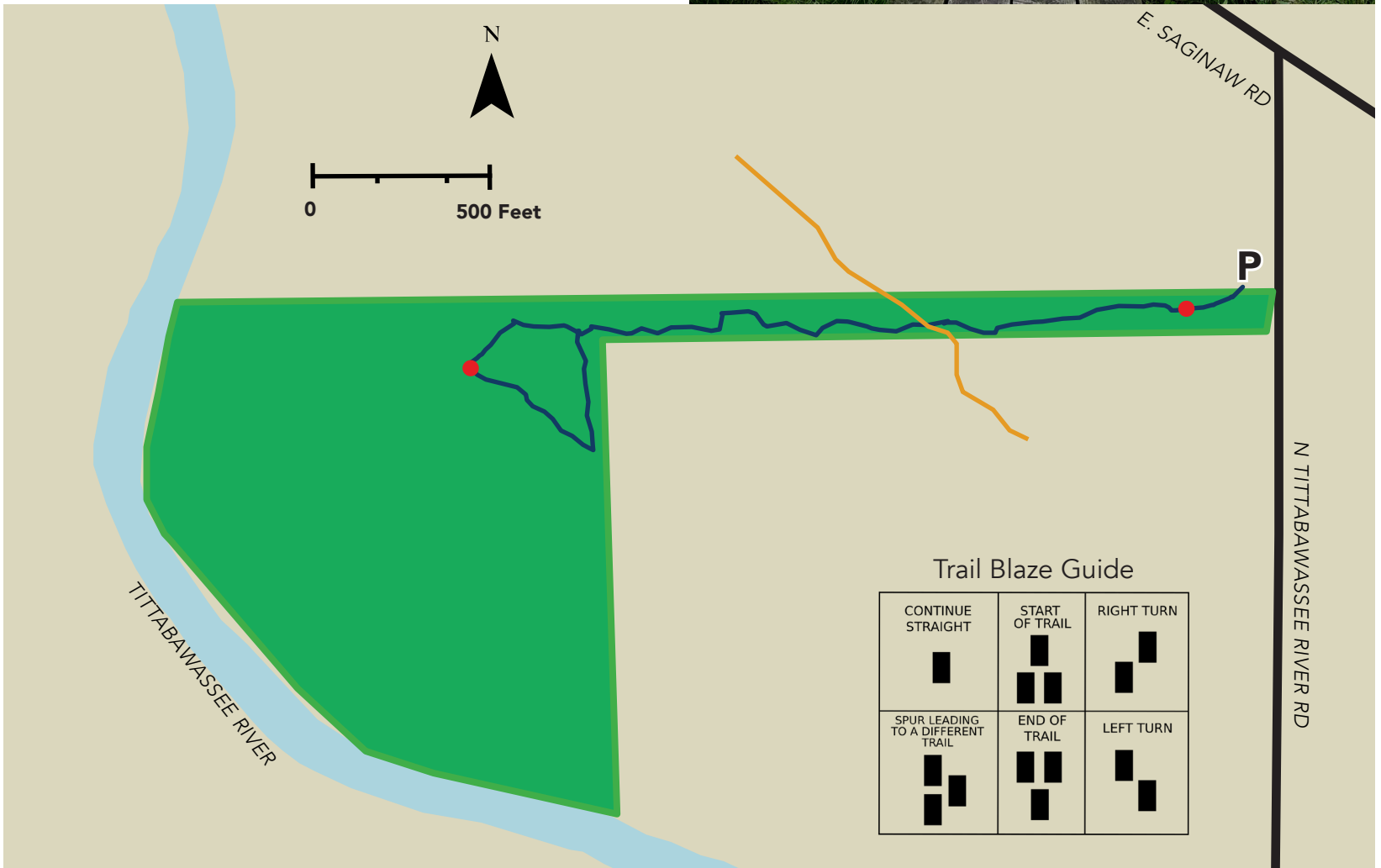
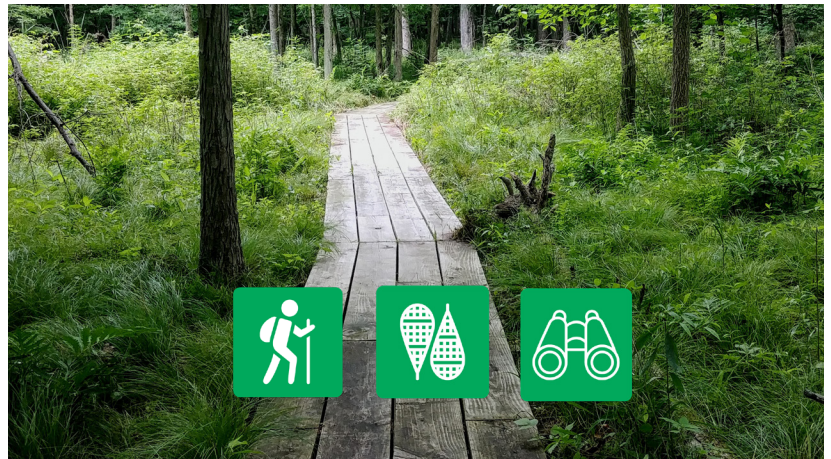

FORESTVIEW NATURAL AREA

An impressive wetland area, this 70-acre property is home to many species of amphibians. This 1.3-mile trail has plenty to see with an abundance of wildflowers and ferns on the forest floor. Boardwalks and bridges help trail users navigate through the wetlands leading through a red and white pine stand, planted in the 1970's, to a ridge of hemlocks.
